Claim.—In a wrench, the combination with a handle, a fixed jaw. a shank having a longitudinal groove or recess in one side, a movable jaw, and a detachable rod carried thereby moving in the groove or recess in the shank and having serrations on its inner face, of a clamp pivoted in the shank and having a serrated clamping face engaging with the serrated rod and a thumb piece extending externally down the handle, and a spring plate for normally forcing the said clamping face into engagement with the serrated rod, substantially as described.



A ledger comprised of one or more folios, each folio divided into a plurality of sections to correspond with a similar division of the year, a name column for each folio, a ledger number column between the name column and the adjoining section of the folio, a corresponding ledger number column opposite each of the remaining sections, each section subdivided into debit and credit columns, the accounts adapted to read across the book, substantially as specified. 2nd. A ledger comprised of a plurality of folios, each folio divided into debit and credit sections, a name column for each folio, a ledger number column for each name column, and a numerical index at one side of the ledger for the folio, substantially as specified. 3rd. A ledger comprised of a plurality of folios, each folio divided into debit and credit sections, a name column for each folio, a ledger number column for each name column, a numerical index at one side of the ledger for the folios, and a corresponding numerical index at the foot of the ledger, substantially as specified. 4th. A ledger comprised of one or more folios, each folio divided into a plurality of sections to correspond with a similar division of the year, each section divided into debit and credit subdivisions, a name column for each folio, in which may be entered the name of the account, the subdivisions of the sections so arranged as to allow the account reading across the ledger, substantially as specified. 5th. A ledger comprised of one or more folios, each folio divided into a plurality of sections to correspond with a similar division of year, each section divided into debit and credit subdivisions, a name column for each folio, a ledger number column between the name column and the first folio section, and a corresponding ledger number column adjoining each of the temaining folio sections, the ledger numbers in each of the said columns corresponding, substantially as specified. 6th. A ledger comprised of one or more folios, each folio divided into a plurality of sections, to correspond with a similar division of the year, each section divided into debit and credit subdivisions, the debit subdivision divided into a column for the balance carried over from the end of the preceding period, and a column for the goods purchased during the current period, the credit subdivision divided into a column for the payment made during the current period, and a column for the total of the said payments, substantially as specified. 7th. A ledger comprised of one or more substantiary as specimed.
