Februarius, from *Februa*, name of the sacrifices which took place during this month, — was the last month of the year during the earlier ages of Rome, but the December placed it next to January.

This was the first month of the Romulean year, and was so named because Romulus dedicated it to Mars.

April, *Aprilis*, is derived from the word *aperire*, to open, because, in this month, the earth seems to open and bring forth fresh products.
