Section II.—Frequency of Exhibitions

The frequency of international exhibitions to which the present convention ies shall be governed by the fallowing and aged ages of grandmayor Arricle 4 applies shall be governed by the following principles:-

All general exhibitions fall into one of the two following categories: First category: Those in which the countries invited to participate are to construct national participate are

Second category: Those in which such countries are not so obliged.
