

or service passports may obtain, upon entry to Canada and Turkey, visas valid for an unlimited number of entries to or departures from Canada and Turkey during the appointment of the representatives and officials concerned or for the period of validity of their passports, whichever is the lesser.

5. This agreement shall supersede the Exchanges of Notes (February 15 and 28, 1949¹ and February 9, 1951², 32740/4 and 395/7 and C/4) between Canada and Turkey concerning respectively the issuance of temporary visas and of multi-entry visas to diplomatic representatives and officials.
6. (a) The present agreement shall enter into force one month after the date of signature.
- (b) Either of the Parties to this agreement may suspend it temporarily for reasons of public order, and the suspension must be notified to the other Party immediately through the diplomatic channel.
- (c) Each of the Parties reserves the right to terminate the present agreement subject to two months' notice.

If the Turkish Government is prepared to accept the foregoing provisions, I have the honour to suggest that the present Note and Your Excellency's reply in identical terms shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
