Working Holiday Program with Korea

What is it? In the spirit of cultural understanding and co-operation, young Canadian citizens are given an opportunity to visit Korea for an extended holiday, and to meet their travel expenses through occasional employment.

How long can I stay? The Korean Working Holiday visa has an initial duration of six months and may be extended for a second consecutive six-month period while in Korea.

Who can apply?

To be eligible, applicants must:

- be 18 to 25 years of age;
- be a Canadian citizen currently residing in Canada;
- possess a valid passport and a return travel ticket, or sufficient funds to purchase a return ticket;
- have reasonable funds, including funds to cover medical expenses, during the period of initial stay in Korea.
