

The Order of the Day being read, for resuming the adjourned Debate on the Question, which was on Wednesday 27th January last proposed, That in the opinion of this House tenders received in any Department of Government should be immediately placed in safe custody under seal so as to prevent any possibility or suspicion of tampering; and should be opened in public at the time and place mentioned in the advertisement and in the presence of at least three principal officials of the department; and the persons so tendering or their duly authorized agents should be at liberty to attend at the said time and place and see such tenders opened and recorded, if they so desire;

And proposed amendment thereto, That all the words after "That" to the end of the Question be left out, and the words "the method of inviting, opening and "considering tenders, as embodied in the Order in Council of 18th January, 1909, "is in the opinion of this House, a proper safeguard of the public interests," inserted instead thereof;

And the Question on the amendment being again proposed.—The House resumed the said adjourned Debate,
