Read second time, and referred to Committee on Banking, etc., 142. Reported, 413. Considered in Committee of the Whole; reported; read third time; passed, 430. Passed by Senate, 701. Royal Assent, 847.—62-63 Victoria, Chapter 46.
2. Bill (No. 2) an Act to amend the Criminal Code, 1892, with respect to Seduction, etc.; presented: Mr. Charlton, 52. Read second time, 141. Considered in Committee of the Whole; reported, 218. Motion for third reading agreed to on a division. Read third time; passed, 255.
