## SKETCH OF THE KNIGHTS OF PYTHIAS.

The Knights of Pythias possesses just claims to be one of the foremost of the benevolent institutions whose object is the elevation and benefit of the interests of brotherhood through unity of effort well known to the world. The Society first took shape on the evening of February 19th, 1818, its founder, Justus H. Rathbone (still living) gathered about the city of Washington, D.C., a number of gentlemen and explained the foundation principles of the Order of Knights of Friendship, Benevolence and Civilization, the objects of which were to unite the original members is given on the proposal meeting with the approval of those present subscribed to an obligation of and proceeded to name the Society officers, and adopt a ritual.
