

Fishing and Hunting. This is the last Town in the *Western Division* of the Province.

FROM *Chidapouchi* the Coast of the Isthmus is full of Inhabitants, who are settled in a String of Villages, that extends to the River of *Chignitou*, which has a very narrow but deep Channel. Upon the North Side of which, and about two Leagues from its Mouth, stands the Town of that Name, and forms the *Frontier* of the *Southern Division*, or the *Peninsula*, the Isthmus of which is no more than two Leagues across at this Place. *Chignitou* is a large Town, containing about two hundred Families, and is situated on a healthy Spot, having an extensive Opening to the West of beautiful large Meadows, which being interspersed with small Villages on the Banks of several navigable Rivers, the whole makes a very agreeable Landscape. All round the Bottom of the Bay, and on its Southern Shore, are large Tracts of Marsh Lands, which is the Reason why this Side is better peopled than the other.

About 50 Miles S. W. from hence stand the Town and Parish of *Cobegnuit*, at the Entrance of the Settlements of the *French*, who have spread all over this Part of the *Peninsula*, for several Leagues, round the
