Propagation, is in my humble Opinion a Loss scarce ever to be repaired.

Now at the end of this last War behold the miserable Condition of France, her Manusactures decay'd, her Navy gone to ruin, her best Blood spilt, her People dispirited, her Credit gone, and her Treasure exhausted. With these sad Effects of Ambition, Tyranny, and Pride, I close the last Scene of this Period and Lewis's Reign.

SUCH were the Evils under which France labour'd, when the Duke of Orleans enter'd upon the Regency. As the Case was desperate, so the Remedy he applied was violent.

FINDING the National Debt of a Size too enormous to be managed with ease to the State or Justice to the publick Creditor, all publick Payments in Arrear, the King's Revenue extremely reduced by the Calamities of the War, and the Poverty of the People; he form'd a Design to fill the King's Cossers without Taxes, and discharge the publick
