TRANSPORTATION PLAN ADOPTED Controllers Approve Questions to Be Submitted to Ratepayers

The chief business before the board of control yesterday was the discussion and adoption of the mayor's transportation plan, which provides for certain questions being submitted to the ratepayers on Jan. 1 next. The chief question to be answered is: "Are you in favor of the operation of the Toronto Railway System by a civic commission consisting of three ratepayers, resident in the municipality, appointed by the city council?"

In his proposals, the mayor laid down the following line of policy: (1) The civic car lines to be operated by R. C. Harris up to 1921. The commissioner, when appointed by the legislature, to plan new routes, build cars, and to raise debentures not exceeding \$5,000,000. Also to report on the needs of the city for further transportation by buses and radials, and to prepare the way with rolling stock for 1921.

Refused to Vote. The first clause was carried on a division, and on the remainder, or points of policy, clauses being put. Controller Cameron refused to vote, stating it had all been fixed up before hand. Controller Maguire objected to such a statement, when Controller Cameron retorted: "You can object all you damn well please." In the end, the mayor's scheme was carried by the votes of Controller Maguire and Robbins, but the argument before a division was taken were of a very heated nature. The original scheme recommended a commission of six members, and Controller McBride took great exception to the mayor's amendment, saying: "All these reports are turned down because you want to get some outsider a job." The mayor: "I have been studying this question for the past two years." Controller McBride: "You have been studying yourself."

VICTORY LOAN HONOR BANNER COMPETITION ONTARIO EMPLOYEES COMMITTEE 100% VICTORY LOAN 1919

One of the most interesting features in connection with the Victory Loan is the campaign among employees in establishments throughout the Province. The campaign has to do with subscriptions of employees only, and a Prince of Wales Honor Banner is awarded to each establishment reaching its objective. This objective is based on two things, viz.: That 75 per cent. of the employees subscribe, and their subscriptions aggregate an amount equal to at least 10% of the concern's annual pay roll. In addition a crest that may be attached to the banner is awarded to each concern securing subscriptions from 90% of its employees, and a second crest in the event of 100% of the employees buying bonds, also one crest is awarded for each increase of 25% over the amount of the original objective.

There is keen competition among establishments to see which will win the greatest number of crests. The following list shows the establishments in Ontario, excluding Toronto, that have already been awarded the Banner, together with the number of crests won by each. The list will be published in this paper daily:
