CHEAP TREATMENT OF ORE.

New Process Fathomed by a Golden, B.C., Man.

Metals Extracted by Means of "Fermentation" and Precipitation—Big Company Formed to Take over a Roseland Group of Mines—Mining Stocks.

Perhaps no problem in the scientific world is attracting more attention to-day than the economical extraction of metals from their original ores. Process after process has been perfected during the last quarter of a century, and still the list grows. The latest process has scarcely passed the experimental stage, but already bears the stamp of success. It is called the "Zymean Process."

The crushed ore is placed in vats, treated with a saturated solution of salt. To this is added dichloride of sulphur and nitrate of soda. The contents of the vat are then heated up to just below the boiling point. In a few minutes the solution passes into solution and the sulphur can then be filtered off.
