END OF THE O. R. A. SHOOTING

Team and Company Firing Better Than Last Year—Average of Individuals Higher.

ARMSTRONG WINS THE MULLOCK

El Padre, Needles and Rapid-Firing Competition—Finish of the Scoring.

In consequence of the big program of matches shot off on Thursday, the last day of the O. R. A. meet, the results were not all ready for publication yesterday, and the remaining prize lists are published below.

The team and company shooting, in particular, this year, was much better than last year, while the individual shooting, generally, averaged a little higher.

Pte. P. Armstrong is the winner of the "Mulluck" for grand aggregate score, and carries off the Elkhington Cup, the N.R.A. silver medal and badge, and \$15, his score being 283. Last year a score of 277 won the cup. The lowest score, the prize for this year is 270, while 257 won a prize last year.

The El Padre Needles and the Rapid-Firing competitions averaged the same as last year, but the scores in the revolver match are not as good as last year. Thirty-two is the best this year, while 24 last year, the other scores being away down. This is accounted for by the fact that the revolver shooting, except while a due weapon, is hardly the kind of skill that is required in the other matches, the shots being calculated for the finest shooting.
