

Toronto Junction, May 29.—The regular monthly meeting of the board of works was held to-night, Councillor Ryding, chairman. presiding, and Mayor Smith, Councillors Armstrong, Whetter and Ford present. The application for a fire hydrant at the corner of Kennedy and D'Arcy-streets could not be acceded to, as at present the work is impracticable. The matter of water pipe extensions was left to Chairman Ryding with instructions to present a full report at the meeting of the executive committee on Thursday night. The placing of public drinking troughs will also be dealt with on Thursday night. The Southern Light and Power Co, asked for permission to place their poles on that part of the town adjoining Bloor-street and connecting York Township with Toronto, over which the company already has running rights. Referred to executive, John Witheridge and other residents of Union-street asked for a sidewalk on the west side of the street, and the request was referred to Street Foreman Moon to report to council ast to probable cost.
