PRINCE OF WALES Is Given an Enthusiastic Welcome at Capital of the Colony.

Hamilton Bermuda, Oct. 1. — The Prince of Wales, homeward bound from Australia on the British battle cruiser Renown, arrived here today from Antigua for a three days' visit. During his stay, the prince will take part in the concluding ceremonies of Bermuda's tercentenary, which is link-ed with the Jamestown, Va., tercentenary and those of the sailing of the

pilgrims for America. Virtually every one of Bermuda's 20,000 inhabitants was astir early today for the festivities of the prince's visit. Early this morning the Rencwn bearing the prince and his party, ar rived off the northern end of the island, accompanied by the cruiser Calcutta.



Immediately the Renown was noarded by Bermuda's governor, Sir James Willcocks, and Rear Admiral Allan F. Everett, commanding the North Ameriwood, the chief secretary for Ireland, in a speech on the occasion of a dis-tribution of medals.
