

TENDERS FOR HENVEY INLET

SEALED TENDERS addressed to the undersigned and marked on the envelope "Tender for Henvey Inlet Timber" will be received up till 3 p.m. of Thursday, May 17, 1945, for the purchase of the merchantable timber on Henvey Inlet Indian Reserve No. 2, District of Parry Sound, Ontario.

The Reserve has an area of approximately 23,811 acres and is estimated to contain approximately 25,900 cords of poplar, jackpine, balsam and spruce pulpwood. No timber shall be cut below a diameter six inches breast height. All merchantable timber shall be cut and fully utilized. Any wastage of timber shall be a breach of contract. All logs shall be piled on skidways with logs flush at one end. No timber or pulpwood shall be removed from the Reserve until it has been measured by a qualified Ontario scaler. Slash and debris shall be disposed of so as not to constitute a fire basard and as required by the Ontario Forestry Regulations. Operations shall begin in 1945 and be completed in three years.

Indians of the Ojibbewas of Lake Huron Band shall be given preference in employment.

Tenderers should state the price per cord for pulpwood and the price per M. f.b.m. for saw timber. Tenders to be on forms provided to be accompanied by an accepted cheque to the Receiver General for \$689 covering, first year's rental, \$185, licence fee, \$4, security deposit, \$500.

Cheques will be returned to unsuccessful tenderers. On acceptance of a tender, the security deposit of \$500 will be held until the operation is completed to the satisfaction of the Minister of Mines and Resources. The highest or any tender not necessarily accepted. Forms of tender and copies of Timber Regulations can be had from Samuel Devlin, Indian Agent, Parry Sound, or the undersigned.
