Long before the white people came there were oysters on the Bay. when the white people came took this oysters beds away from the Indians which was about 20 or 30 acres of oysters. these oysters are right on our shore, in front of the reclamation of Oyster Bay which the tide goes off about half a mile, which was our claim long ago.

We are talking of Oysters Bay yet about the road, when our agent Mr. Robertson at the time this road was put through on our claim at Oyster Bay. We want to find out, why they put the road through without our consent and Mr. Robertson told us that the Provincial would pay us when the road was finished. We see on the Indian act on the page 16 number 46 that there
