There have been eleven suicides within eight blocks in Greenwich village in one year. Mrs. Leuos Sherwin of 18 Bast Eighth street, told Mayor Hylan yesterday when she called with other members of a delegation of residents to protest against the licensing of dance halls in the village. Men who own houses that have been made over two-room apartments seem to be immune from the law she said.

"School teachers and artists come to the section because it has had a reputation of being a beautiful, quiet section, and in their study and work they want quiet," she told the Mayor. "Some of them come to see life and they see it with such a vengeance that there have been eleven suicides within eight blocks the past year."

"Were they school teachers?" asked the Mayor.

"Not all, two were, I believe. Young girls come down from the country, who, by their appearance, you can see have been well brought up, come to the neighborhood and week by week you can see them going down. When you complain to the agent about the scenes you are told to move to Cherry Hill or the Bronx."
