Royalty on Furs.

Victoria, B. C., July 8.—Regulations have just been issued by the provincial government providing for the payment of royalties by fur traders on pelts and skins of fur-bearing animals. The amount varies from fifty cents on each bear to \$10 on silver fox. The figure is based on five per cent of the commercial value. A fee of \$25 will be charged for fur traders for permits to buy furs at wholesale from licensed fur traders or at sales of furs at public auction.
