MRS. O'GRADY GIVES REASONS FOR RESIGNATION

New York, Dec. 16.—Mrs. Ellen A. O'Grady, fifth deputy police commissioner who resigned on Monday said to newspaper men:

"Since January, 1919, I have been treated like a dog by the Commissioner. When I and my women detectives tried to arrest some men in his office for outrageous treatment to girls, you remember the case I refer to—ever since that time everything has been against me."

"It culminated when Mrs. Mary Hamilton, a police woman, came into my office, and ignoring me, told Acting Captain Ammon that she wanted two police women to help her work on the police hospital drive, naming Mrs. Sullivan and Mrs. McCarthy. She also said that she wanted Mrs. Goodwin."

"Mrs. Hamilton wanted to use these three women for the police hospital drive, and when I wanted women to search for missing girls I could not get them. There seems to be no women detective and had to work on the case myself."

"They have taken my car away from me, and when I asked for one, Enright said: 'You can't have a car.'"

"All this happened after I started to investigate the doings of a man in his office. I was sick recently, and four days' pay was taken out of my salary."

"I asked Mayor Hylan for a car and he refused to let me have one."

"When my detectives went to enforce the law in moving picture houses the interested in moving pictures, complaining about my detectives investigating moving picture places. I was told that my work was 'too strenuous,' looking after the morals of girls in moving picture houses; and I was told to go slow."

"I have been hounded and hampered for a long time. I have been hounded almost to death."

"I could not hold my self respect and remain in the police department."
