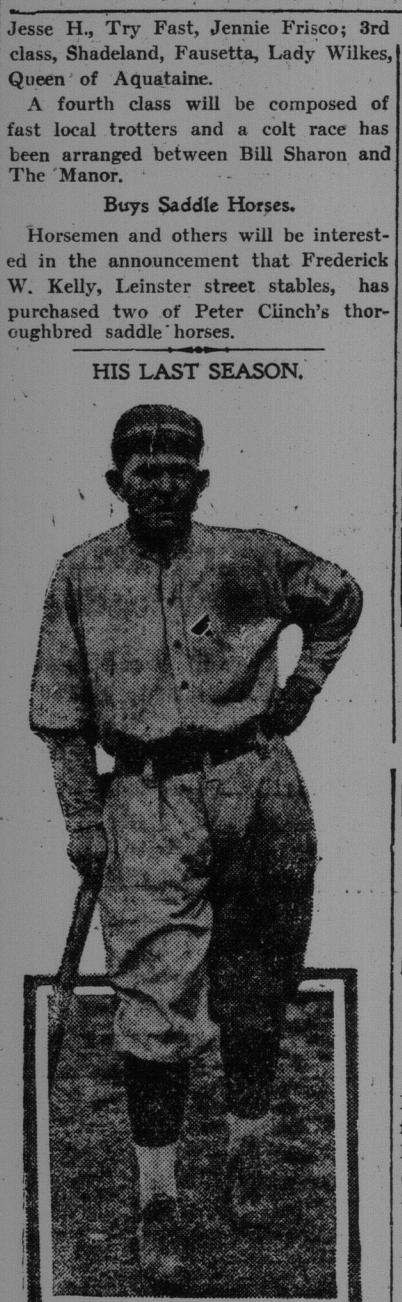

BOLSHEVIKI FORCES AND MUSSULMANS IN DEADLY COMBAT; 2000 KILLED

Fearful Carnage in Baku, on Caspian Sea, Reported—Russians Capture Petrovsk

Moscow, May 19—(By the Associated Press)—Mussulmans and Bolshevik forces are engaged in a deadly conflict at Baku, on the Caspian Sea. According to despatches to the Moscow newspapers 2,000 persons have been killed and 3,000 wounded. Various parts of the town, including entire streets and the Persian bazaar are burning.

Amsterdam, May 20—Russian Bolshevik troops, according to a telegram from Constantinople have succeeded in capturing the town of Petrovsk on the west shore of the Caspian, 200 miles north of Baku and Derentkapi.

LOST BABE FOUND IN JINNEY

Pearl Ferguson, Held as Kidnapper, Says Mother Loaned Her the Child

New York, May 20—Shirley, five months old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Max J. Jacobus of 227 West 21st street, who was kidnapped on May 3, has been returned to her parents, and Pearl Hayner, or Pearl Ferguson, which is her real name, is under arrest in Bridgeport, Conn. The arrest was made after weeks of patient work by Detective Conklin, who found the woman giving the baby an automobile ride. The baby wore a new dress and showed evidence, the detective said, of having been well cared for. The prisoner denied the kidnapping, and said that the baby had been loaned to her by Mrs. Jacobus, known to her by Mrs. Jacobus, who lived next door to the Jacobus family. In March she volunteered to take care of the Jacobus children if she were given a home. This agreement was entered into, and the woman roomed with the family for a week. Then she left.

FRENCH HONORS FOR ZEEBRUGGE RAIDERS

Paris, May 19—(Via Reuter's Ottawa Agency)—The French government has awarded the Croix de Guerre with palm to Vice-Admiral Keyes, Rear Admiral Tyrwhitt, and sixteen other officers who particularly distinguished themselves in the Zeebrugge and Ostend raids.
