Barrels to be firm and well made with knots all puttied, wind and water tight. Find contents by 23 inch diagonal rod from croze to croze—this is the proper size.

This barrel can only be made with steel trusses and cleaned with pluckers, square stave and square point.

Trusses and tools may be imported through the Marine and Fisheries Department on receipt of application from those who desire to have the same. The charge will be cost price nett.


