SIR,

I have the honor to submit the following with reference to the traffic of the Louise Docks and Wharves.

During the past season fifty-one (51) Ocean Mail Steamships, of one hundred and fifty one thousand three hundred and three (151,303) tons register, used the Docks for landing immigrants, baggage, etc., and five thousand three hundred and seventy (5,370) tons of Quebec and Western freight.

Nineteen (19) steamships of fifty five thousand six hundred and eighty-one (55,681) tons register, lightered seven hundred and seventy-one (771) tons of Quebec freight and landed their immigrants.

Twenty-one (21) Ocean Steamships, of forty six thousand three hundred and sixteen (46,316) tons register, landed four thousand eight hundred and forty-seven (4,847) tons of Quebec freight.

Nineteen (19) Steamships of twenty-one thousand one hundred and twelve (21,112) tons register, have used the
