Peking, Dec. 8.—A pitiful attempt of the Peking Government to live up to the hopes of the Washington Conference and to influence the Conference and to influence the Conference's decisions is shown by the official announcement that the Cabinet threatened to resign unless the military and oivil sovernors of the provinces comply with the Government's two-fold order. First, that China's military forces be limited to the number necessary to maintain peace and order, the total not to exceed sixty divisions; and second, that there be a proper division and accounting of previncial and national revenues and the absolute abolition of the likin. Undoubtedly the Central Government would like to enforce a reduction of the army and to establish a proper financial accounting on the part of the provinces, while it would be willing to abolish the likin in return for an increase in the maritime-customs. The fact remains, however, that the Government is too weak to bring these changes about, so the only conclusion possible from the announcement is the hope that it will influence Washington.
