to him, that if he was not afraid it might savour of pomposity, he would like to jurite his name on the hotel books wherever he went, "John Maclean, President of the Dominion Y. M. C. A." He expressed the feeling of loneli ness which he experienced in Paris last year on the Sabbath, till he found the rooms of the Y. M. C. A., and entering them, met with forty young men assembled to read God's Word together. Then he felt, even in Paris, on a Sunday, as if really at home when in the rooms of the Y. M. C. A. He earnestly entreated all who heard him to engage actively in work for the advancement of Christ's kingdom, and related how in answer to prayer, and as signs of approval for his endeavours to win souls, God had blessed him in his business, and brought his three children to a saving faith in Jesus.

The Convention then adjourned to meet on Monday morning at 9.30 to conclude the business of the session.
