BILL.

An Act to incorporate the Canada National Railway and Transport Company.

WIIEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it be Preamble. VV enacled as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House 5 of Commons of Canada, declares and enacts as follows :----

- 20 holders in the company, are incorporated under the name of "The Canada National Railway and Transport Company" Corporate hereinafter called "the Company."

2. The works of the Company are declared to be for the Declaratory. general advantage of Canada.

3. The persons named in section 1 of this Act are constituted Provisional directors. 25 provisional directors of the Company.

4. The capital stock of the Company shall be five million Capital stock. dollars and may be called up by the directors from time to time as they deem necessary, but no one call shall exceed ten per 80 cent on the shares subscribed.

5. The head office of the Company shall be at the city of Head office. Toronto, in the county of York.

6. The annual meeting of the shareholders shall be held on Annual meeting. the first Wednesday in September in each year.

7. At such meeting the subscribers for the capital stock Election of 85 assembled, who have paid all calls due on their shares, shall directors. choose seven persons to be directors of the Company, one or more of whom may be paid directors.
