PREFACE.

This volume provides references, in the form of a general Alphabetical Index to all proceedings of the House of Commons, and to the Sessional Papers of the Parliament of Canada from the year 1891 to the year 1903, inclusive. It is the third of a series, the first of which embraces from 1867 to 1876, inclusive; and the second from 1877 to 1900, inclusive.

The work, in accordance with instructions, has been so prepared as to cover every subject referred to in the Journals during the above-mentioned period. All matters relating to the same subject are brought together under one head, and the record of each is made as complete as possible with references and cross-references.

The whole has been carefully prepared under the direction of Dr. Flint, the Clerk of the House, in accordance with the recommendation of the Joint Committee of the Senate and House of Commons on the Printing of Parliament, presented on the 15th June, 1904, and concurred in by both Houses.
