cover the cost of constructing the building the University would "have to assume contingent liability," said Costello. In essence, the university must guarantee the loan before any financier would cooperate with the

SCC. The university has agreed to do so said Costello.

Costello also emphasized that by looking at other student centres built around the country we can take advantage of the knowledge they have about building a centre and providing its ongoing operating funds.

Only the original hand written copies will be acceptable. Any mechanically duplicated copies will be disqualified.
