location or from the reserve of his band, for sale, the following quantity of timber.....
15 cords of stovewood

on the West Bay Reserve, from the date hereof
until the 30th day of April next, and no longer, subject to the payment of dues at tariff rates.

The purchaser of the timber cut under this permit is responsible for the payment of the dues at the rate shown hereunder. This permit, together with a sworn return of the timber cut, made by a qualified scaler, or other responsible person, also cheque or money order for the amount of dues, should be returned to the undersigned.
