Who is subdividing the township as to the position, nature, and extent of any improvements or cultivation the indians referred may have made on the land, mobractions will be sent to the Dominion Lando agent to be careful that no lutrus or purchases of such lands be medi by other persons, and that in view of the above facto it would be safe to assure. three Indians that they will be allowed to runain in undisturbed possessione of any such portion of a quarter section as they may have cultivated and improved. You will be good wough to Commune He above Jack to the Disense Andrews interested .
