I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 12th instant applying for the position of teacher of the school on the Oak River Reserve.

In reply I beg to say that the Department has decided to try the experiment of re-opening this school under your charge, it to be understood that the appointment is only temporary. Your initial salary will be at the rate of \$300.00 per annum. The Indian Agent, Mr. Hollister, will be written to and asked to have the school ready for occupation as soon as possible.
