at Grosse Ile, Quebec, on the 4th May, 1944, when examined as a witness before a Court-Martial, stated on oath that he did not hear any statement made by Gunner J. C. Beamish, the person charged before the Court, concerning the Men's Canteen of First War Disease Control Station, C.A., well knowing such statement to be false.

SECOND CHARGE:
Section 29,

" WILFULLY GIVING FALSE EVIDENCE
WHEN EXAMINED ON OATH BEFORE A COURT-MARTIAL "

in that he,

at Grosse Ile, Quebec, on the 4th May, 1944, when examined as a witness before a Court-Martial, stated on oath that Gunner J. C. Beamish, the person charged before the Court, never told him that he had stolen goods from the Men's Canteen of First War Disease Control Station, C.A., well knowing such statement to be false.
