

ARTICLE IX.

THE TREASURER.

In addition to the duties laid down in the Constitution, the Treasurer shall deposit all moneys received by him, in a chartered bank in the City of Westmount in the name of the Lodge, and such money shall only be drawn therefrom on the joint signature of the Master and Treasurer.

All accounts authorized to be paid shall be discharged by cheque.

The Treasurer shall be responsible that the jewels and furniture of the Lodge be insured against loss by fire.

ARTICLE X.

FEES AND DUES.

1. *Initiation Fee.*—The initiation fee of this Lodge is established at fifty dollars and shall include the three degrees, Registration fee to the Grand Lodge, Grand Lodge Certificate, copy of the Constitution, copy of the By-Laws and an apron.

2. The fee for a Brother affiliating shall be ten dollars, provided, however, that in the case of a former member of this lodge the fee shall be five dollars.
