

PROLIFIC LAMBING.

On his farm, at Tyddyn Morgan, Abergele, North Wales, Robert Davies, head coachman to Sir Herbert Roberts, M.P. for West Denbighshire, has a ewe that has lambed prolifically during several seasons, and it would be interesting to know whether the record has not been "smashed." Mr. Davies informs a correspondent of the Farmer and Stockbreeder that the numbers dropped were as follows: 1908, three; 1909, four; 1910, seven; 1911, four; 1912, three; total, 21 in five years. Fifteen survived. The previous record is believed to be eighteen in nine years.
