### Saint John's Position

In the course of his speech in the Legislature on Tuesday J. D. McKeppna, M. P. P., said:

"It is suggested that it would be in the interests of the people of this province to have railway connection between the C. N. R. system and United States roads by constructing a branch line from Kingsclear. Some opposition to this has been manifested in the city of Saint John. I am here to say on my own behalf, that I think the time has come in this province, when the city of St. John, in its own interest, must recognize that it cannot hope to derive all the advantages, all the time, from projects which may be suggested for the upholding of this province. And that it must take into consideration the fact that other communities are just as jealous of and zealous for their advancement as the people of Saint John may be of and for theirs."

### Predicts Big Rise in Rubber Prices

Washington, Apr. 4—Harvey S. Firestone asserted here today that the British rubber restriction is again threatening progress and development of highway transportation and may increase the price of rubber tires to American motor owners from \$100,000,000 to \$300,000,000 this year.

In 1922 the British Colonial Office was instrumental in the enactment of legislation limiting production and exportation of rubber from British possessions, allowing only 60 per cent of normal production to be exported. The price of rubber, which was then 15 cents a pound, advanced to 37 cents within a short time.

Restriction was very rigidly applied, Mr. Firestone said after Winston Churchill became Chancellor of the Exchequer in England last year.

"It was only natural to expect Lord Churchill to use his power looking to the rigid enforcement of the Restriction Act," said Mr. Firestone, "as he was Colonial Secretary at the time the legislation was enacted."

### New Comet Has Been Discovered

Lucien Orkish, assistant astronomer at Cracow University, has discovered a new comet. His find has been confirmed by Copenhagen Observatory.

The comet is visible through small telescopes. This is the first time such a discovery has been made by a Polish astronomer.

### A Music Festival

Seventy-five thousand spectators are expected to attend the Philadelphia Music Festival, June 3. There will be a massed chorus of 2,200 voices solo singers from the Philadelphia Civic Opera Company; eighty players from the Philadelphia orchestra and 1,000 amateur bandmen. Forty choral and other musical organizations will take part. The programme as at present outlined will include the second act of Aida, using the chorus of 2,200 singers and a ballet of 500, under the direction of Alexander Smallens. The massed choruses will sing: The Heavens Declare, by Beethoven; Land of Hope and Glory, Elgar. America and a Bach chorale. The 1,000 amateur bandmen will be directed by John Philip Sousa.



### MAY SHIELD BEARS TO SAVE FORESTS

FREDERICTON, April 9 A closed season on hunting bears from May until November each year is proposed under the provisions of a bill introduced in the Provincial Legislature to-day by Hon. Dr. Hetherington. The object of the bill, it was stated, is not to protect the bears, but to help lessen the forest fire menace, not that the bears are suspected of causing fires but many people have been using bear hunting as an excuse for being in the woods at a time when the forest fire hazard is at its worst and it has been found that the fewer hunters, campers and others in the woods, the fewer the chances of fires originating and causing tremendous damage to the Crown lands as well as privately owned land.
