# FOUR ITALIANS ARE GUILTY OF CHARGE OF SHOOTING

Jury Finds That Two Did Actua Bodily Harm While the Othe Two Assembled for that Purpose on Sunday, Feb. 16 on Street in Riverside

SENTENCE WILL BE PRONOUNCED LATER

Case Arose From the Desire for a Drink on Sunday, One of the Four Being Suspected of Being in League With Li cense Inspectors.

The first verdict of guilty by a jury at the present session of the crimnial assizes was returned yesterday afternoon when four Italians were convicted, two of doing bodily harm and the other two with them of assembling to do bodily harm. This was the last jury trial of the session, and all those summoned were informed by His Honor Judge Beck that they might return home.
