A PRESENT FOR FRANCE

French Consulate Presents Waterloo Field to Republic.

Paris, Feb. 6. — In M. Orlis, the Frenchman, with the Egyptian name, France has a philanthropist who is as persistent in giving as the Scotch-American, Mr. Carnegie. He is also an ardent devotee of Napoleonism and here are two of his latest presentation plans.

In the first place he has bought a great part of the field of Waterloo, and proposes to erect a monument there to the memory of the 30,000 Frenchmen who fell in the great battle. He began to acquire parts of the land in 1900, and when last year the society known as La Sabretaille failed to secure sufficient subscriptions to erect the late M. Gerome's magnificent monument "The Dying Eagle" at Waterloo, M. Orlis came forward and offered to bear the entire expense. The Frenchman, however, did not see his way to place the work in the hands of a private individual.

M. Orlis therefore quietly went on purchasing land in the neighborhood of the battlefield. He now proposes to erect a monument there that will rival the pyramids of Egypt, and to offer the land and monument to the French Government.

The other gift of M. Orlis to France is that of the famous chateau of Malmaison, which has just been accepted by the state. The chateau, which is about 20 miles from Paris, was the residence of Josephine, who purchased it in 1798.

It was abandoned by the imperial court for St. Cloud, where Josephine retired after her divorce, and died there in 1814. Napoleon stayed there five days after the battle of Waterloo, during the siege of Paris, and the park of La Malmaison was the scene of a fierce attack between the French and Germans.
