OTTAWA, July 6.—As a step in the development of Canada's foreign trade, the department of trade and commerce has arranged with the Universities of Toronto and McGill to give a special course for export managers.

The course at Toronto is scheduled to begin on Jan. 15, 1923, and will continue for two weeks, while that at McGill will commence on Jan. 29.

## FINISH PLAN OF SERBIAN DEFENSE

BELGRADE, July 6.—The ministers of war, foreign affairs and the interior yesterday completed a detailed plan for the protection of Serbian frontiers against raiding bands of Bulgarians, and for the cleaning out of raiders now in Serbian territory.

They are sending the plan to the Greek cabinet for approval with a view to the two countries acting in agreement.

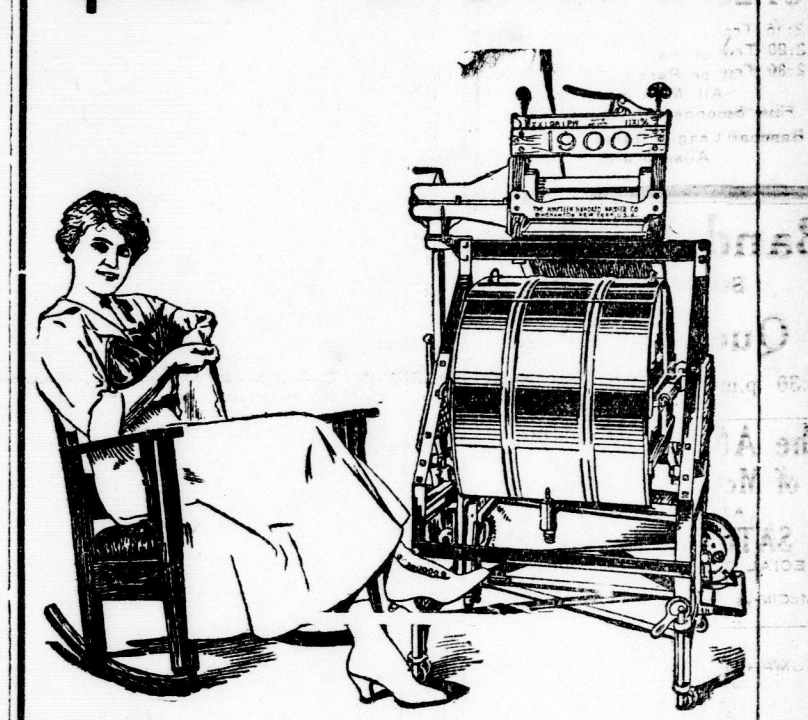
