Chatham, April 4.—The Kent County Council, at its closing session oday, adopted its road program for the year, increasing the estimates of various road expenditures, as recommended by the road committee. by \$34,000. The original estimates called for a total estimates by \$34,000. The original estimates called for a total expenditure of \$152,302, of which the county would have to raise \$85,486 by levy.
