Board of Missions and Church Society are complied with; and in making any new grants it shall be stated how long the grant is to continue".—

It was moved by Rev. H. Holland, seconded by Rev. A. J. Fidler, That the motion of which notice was given by Mr. Gaviller at the last meeting, be referred to the Committee new appointed.—Carried.

After an adjournment, and business being resumed, the Rev. Dr. Beaven in the chair;

It was moved by Rev. S. Givins, seconded by Rev. A. J. Fidler, That the following gentlemen be a Committee to estimate the sum required for missions during the ensuing year, and to apportion the same amongst the several districts, such sum to be estimated in respect of what may be contributed by the various parishes towards the Missionary's support: Rev. Dr. Beaven, Rev. Dr. Greene, Rev. F. L. Osler, Rev. C. J. S. Bethune, Rev. J. Davidson.—Carried.
