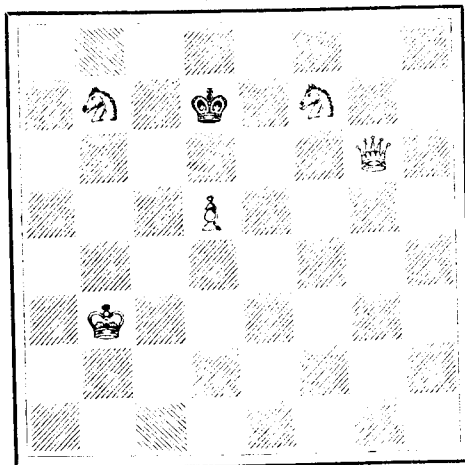


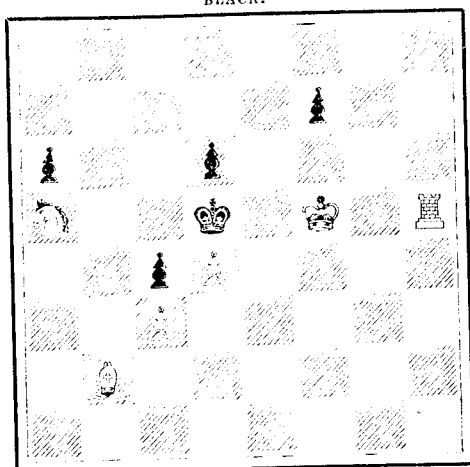

NOTES BY GUNSBURG.

- (a) The old form of French defence is renewed, the newer move of B-Kt 5 being doubtful.
- (b) A well-known method to get an advantage. If Black plays B x Kt, White can play K-R 1 and R-Kt 1, then P-B 3 and Q-B 2, etc., etc.
- (c) The usual place for the Q in this opening.
- (d) A good developing move.
- (e) Danger for White in this exchange.
- (f) Bold: White offers KR P for an uncertain attacking prospect.
- (g) Declines the offer on grounds of safety, but the position may keep.
- (h) If B x Kt, B x B and White Q is driven out of play.
- (k) No prospect of either player obtaining an advantage now.

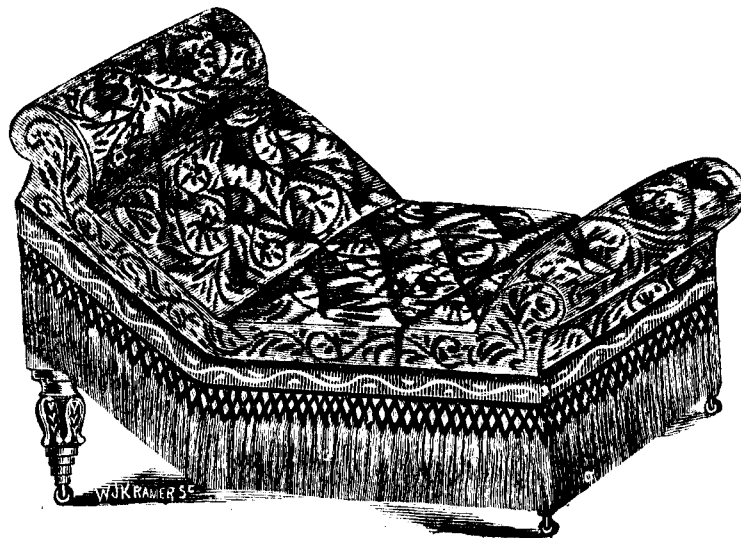
