ARTICLE III

Unless otherwise indicated, the Government of Canada shall assume the responsibilities described in Annex "A" and the Government of Sudan shall assume the responsibilities described in Annex "B" in respect of any specific project established under a subsidiary arrangement. Annexes "A" and "B" shall be integral parts of this Agreement.

ARTICLE IV

For the purposes of this Agreement:

- (a) "Canadian firms" means Canadian or other non-Sudanese firms or institutions engaged in any project under a subsidiary arrangement;
- (b) "Canadian personnel" means Canadian or non-Sudanese or other nonpermanent residents of Sudan working in that country on any project established under a subsidiary arrangement; and
- c) "dependents" means
 - (i) the spouse of a member of the Canadian personnel, including a person of the opposite sex with whom the member of the Canadian personnel has lived and publicly represented as his spouse for a period of not less than one year before the commencement of his period of service in Sudan,
 - (ii) a child of the member of the Canadian personnel or his spouse who is;
 - (A) under twenty-one years of age and dependent on the member of the Canadian personnel or his spouse for support, or
 - (B) twenty-one years of age or older and dependent on the member of the Canadian personnel or his spouse for support by reason of a mental or physical incapacity,

but not including a child from a previous marriage who does not normally reside with the member of the Canadian personnel or his spouse.

ARTICLE V

The Government of Sudan shall indemnify and save harmless the Government of Canada, Canadian firms and Canadian personnel from civil liability for acts performed in the course of their duties except where it is legally established by a Sudanese court of law that such acts result from gross negligence or wilful misconduct on their part.

ARTICLE VI

The Government of Sudan shall facilitate the repatriation of Canadian personnel and of their dependents in cases where, in the opinion of the Government of Canada or the Government of Sudan, the life or safety of said personnel and of their dependents are endangered as a result of events occurring inside or outside of Sudan.
