General Comments:

The most significant items for Canada are salted cod, frozen lobster and frozen prawns. Cod is imported as raw material for bacalao production for re-export to Latin countries. Norwegian catch quotas for cod were reduced during the last two years and are likely to remain low, which will increase the need for imports. The market for frozen lobster is rising and this trend is expected to continue. Due to the cut in Norwegian prawn quotas, the need to import is expected to remain high.
