

ANNEX

1. In the operation of the agreed services on the specified routes set out in the Schedule of Routes hereunder, an airline or airlines designated by the Government of Canada shall have the following rights:

- (a) to put down and take on in the territory of Greece international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo destined for and coming from Canada;
- (b) to carry international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo between Canada and intermediate points;
- (c) to carry into and out of the territory of Greece, in direct transit through international traffic originating in or destined for points in third countries specified in the schedule of routes;
- (d) to omit on any, or all flights, any one or more of the intermediate points.

2. In the operation of the agreed services on the specified routes set out in the Schedule of Routes hereunder, an airline or airlines designated by the Hellenic Government shall have the following rights:

- (a) to put down and take on in the territory of Canada international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo destined for and coming from Greece;
- (b) to carry international traffic in passengers, mail and cargo between Greece and intermediate points;
- (c) to carry into and out of the territory of Canada, in direct transit through international traffic originating in or destined for points in third countries specified in the schedule of routes;
- (d) to omit on any, or all flights, any one or more of the intermediate points.

3. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to confer on an airline of one Contracting Party the privilege of taking up, in the territory of the other Contracting Party passengers, cargo or mail carried for remuneration or hire and destined for another point in the territory of the other Contracting Party.
