

Pedro Cerisola Weber

Secretary of Communications and Transportation

Pedro Cerisola was born in Mexico City on March 13, 1949. He studied architecture at the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) and at Ibero-American University. He also studied executive business administration at the Pan-American Executive Business Management Institute.

In 1984, Mr. Cerisola was a professor at the UNAM faculty of architecture. He has also worked as the director of civil aeronautics for the Secretariat of Communications and Transportation and operations director for Aeroméxico. In 1988, he was responsible for the creation of Aerovías de Mexico and became its general manager.

In eight years with Mexican Telephone Company Ltd., he directed operations and planning and was regional general manager.

Mr. Cerisola became Secretary of Communications and Transportation on Dec. 1, 2000.
