The Secretary of State for External

Affairs, the Honourable Don Jamieson, announces that
he will be paying an official visit to Yugoslavia at
the invitation of the Vice-President of the Federal
Executive Council and Federal Secretary for Foreign
Affairs of the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia,
Mr. Milos Minic, from June 26 to 28, 1977. The two
ministers will be reviewing the international situation
with particular emphasis on the North-South dialogue
and the results of the Conference on International
Economic Cooperation as well as on nuclear nonproliferation and East-West relations. It is expected
there will be an exchange of views on other bilateral
and multilateral topics of interest to both countries.

Mr. Jamieson's visit to Belgrade will continue the now established pattern whereby the Canadian and Yugoslav foreign ministers meet periodically to consult on matters of mutual concern. The last such exchange took place when Mr. Minic visited Ottawa in September 1975.

Mr. Jamieson will arrive from Paris, where he will be attending the OECD\*Council ministerial meeting June 23 and 24. Following his visit to Yugoslavia Mr. Jamieson will be addressing the Canada Club in London on June 30, 1977.
