PARENTS.

UNITED KINGDOM	Dependency Pension up to \$227.76 which may amount to \$455.00 when dependence was on two or more sons who have fallen, or, need pension up to \$227.76, or, flat rate pension of \$62.92 which may amount to \$189.80 where three sons have fallen.
CANADA	A pension graded according to degree of dependency or need and which may amount up to \$576.00 if there are no other dependents.
AUSTRALIA	Widowed mother of unmarried son \$253.06. To other parents such rates as may be assessed by the Pension Board, not exceeding in any one case \$253.06.
NEW ZEALAND	Widowed mother \$189.80 to \$379.60 according to dependence. To other dependent parents the amount of pre-enlistment dependency. To parents in need, such pension as the Board thinks fit.
SOUTH AFRICA	Generally on the Imperial Basis, but may be granted up to \$347.96 under the Defence Act.

DEPENDENTS OTHER THAN LISTED ABOVE.

UNITED KINGDOM	(1) Incapable of self support and in need up to \$174.02 and bonus. (2) Not otherwise entitled, a gratuity not exceeding a year's pay of deceased soldier. Unmarried wife—\$126.36 per annum with children's allowance as per table.
CANADA	Unmarried wife—In certain circumstances to be granted a widow's pension and allowances. Dependent Brothers and Sisters—If no widow or children up to the same rates as children.
AUSTRALIA	Unmarried wife—In certain circumstances to be granted a widow's pension. Others—Such rates as may be assessed by the Pensions Board, not exceeding in any one case \$253.06.
NEW ZEALAND	Unmarried wife—No special provision, but may receive \$253.06 whilst caring for man's children, with children's allowances. If dependent and in need she might also be granted a pension.
SOUTH AFRICA	Others—The amount of pre-enlistment dependency. Unmarried wife—On the Imperial basis. Others—On the Imperial basis.

Note:—The pensions to widows, motherless children, and dependents may be substantially increased under the Union of South Africa Defence Act, 1919.

Note:—The rates for Canada include a bonus for one year to take effect September 1st, 1919.

Mr. ROWELL: The next comparative statement I have relates to training allowances paid by the different countries to returned discharged soldiers being trained for civilian occupation. It is a rather lengthy statement and I should be glad if

the House would consent to have it incorporated in Hansard.
