

such Degrees, but shall be returned by the P. S. should such candidate be refused.

37.—For every Visiting Card a charge of 30c. shall be made, except as hereinafter provided for, and for each Withdrawal Card a charge of 50c.

FUNDS.

38.—There shall be carried to the Credit of the Contingent Fund such money as may be provided by donation, resolution, or otherwise, but in no case from the funds of the Lodge; all other moneys accruing to the Lodge, except such as may be provided for any special fund, shall be carried to the credit of the General Benefit Fund.

ASSESSMENTS.

39.—Whenever any Benefit or Benefits may become due from the fund of this Lodge in the course of any one quarter, if the books of the Lodge do not show a sufficient amount to the credit of the fund to meet such Benefit, then the P. S. shall forthwith raise in aid of the fund by an assessment to be laid in equal proportions upon all members of the Lodge, the amount necessary to meet such Benefit or Benefits.

INVESTMENT OF FUNDS.

40.—Investment of any moneys of the Lodge, which the Lodge may not deem necessary to keep in immediate possession of the Treasurer to meet ordinary disbursements, shall be made in and by the name of the Lodge (if incorporated, otherwise in the names of the Trustees of the Lodge) from time to time, in such manner and with such security as the Lodge may require; provided always that no part of the funds shall be loaned to any member of the Order. All evidences or certificates of such investments shall be kept by the Trustees, and all dividends, interest or other income accruing therefrom shall be duly demanded and received by them, and the amount thereof paid over forthwith to the P. S. for delivery to the Treasurer.

41.—All moneys of the Lodge, not invested as aforesaid, shall remain in the hands of the Treasurer subject to the By-laws and orders of the Lodge.

42.—No motion in any way relating to the investment of the funds of this Lodge, as provided by the By-laws, shall be put to vote at any meeting, whether regular or special, un-
