the Year Fifty-fix were expected to be managed with the greatest Vigour and Difpatch. But whoever expected it, was furely deceived bo The fame dilatory Spirit Rill Julling our Councils, and retarding our Action. Nor will this Complaint appear unjust, when it is confidered, that the Supplies fent to America were not embarked till the latter End of April; that the General appointed to command the Forces, and who, therefore, should have been at their Head as early as possible, did not go forward till a Month after these; and feveral of the Officers and the Ammunition, not till a Month after him. The discreet Method of shipping the Ammunition is so well known, that it need not be mentioned.
