COUNTY PROTECTED AGAINST ACCIDENTS

Protective Policy Covering
Claims of \$5,000 and
\$10,000 Taken Out.

Damage claims amounting to \$5,000 for one person or \$10,000 for two persons hurt on the county roads or middlesex through any fault in the road bed are now provided for by the

action taken at the county buildings yesterday by a special committee appointed by the county council to arrange for the county's protection against financial loss through such accidents.

After a lengthy discussion of the matter the committee decided to take out a protective policy for the amounts named at a yearly premium of \$250. The policy covers accidents of any kind that may occur through bad roadways, the onus of proof that the accident for which a damage claim is made was caused through fault in the roadway will rest with the claimant.
